


Disruption Notice

Cycle Ride 9th June



On the 9th June around 300 cyclists will take part in a strictly non-competitive cycle ride from Darlington across the area towards the Buttertubs. It's an event known as a "Sportive" in which family and leisure riders take part as a challenge, mostly looking to get fit and many doing it for charity. It's an event which has the support of the police and local authorities.

Riders will pass through your area in small groups for the duration of the day. They are briefed that they must follow the rules of the road at all times and behave in a courteous manner to other road users. They will be identified by a small white card on the front of their bike.

At the start from 08:00 – 09:00 the groups will be bigger, however these will quickly disperse into much smaller groups, mostly of 2 or 3 riders. All will be back at Darlington by 17:00 and the event will then close

You will notice some signs placed around the roads, we put these up to guide the riders. These will be put up on the 9th June and removed on the day of the event once the last rider has passed.

We want to make you aware of this ride passing your area and be clear about what it is and when it will take place. It's an event which the local authorities have been made aware of and any concerns raised will be taken into consideration.

We have trained motor bikes and following vans to assist them and help in event of incident.
